Personal Information required for competition:

Swimmer's results are also posted on the Winnipeg Wave website and may be posted on Swim Manitoba's website. As this is age group swimming, the swimmer's name, gender, age and results are automatically included in these reports. As well, in order to assist swimmers, parents/guardians and Wave coaches determine the specific events a swimmer will swim at a meet, we also post the events and swimmer's best times.
